

PROPERTY OVERVIEW

One Mercantile (formerly the Unum building), located at One Mercantile Street in downtown Worcester, is situated in the heart of Worcester's thriving business district. Centrally located in New England to all major cities, this top-of-class, one of a kind asset is primed for business relocation and expansion, while retaining and recruiting a talented workforce. This seven-story, 214,000 square-foot LEED Silver sustainable office building was constructed in 2012, making it the newest Class A building in Worcester. The property has a newly-renovated 860-car parking garage and up to 100,000 square feet of space for tenants. The building is zoned to accommodate a variety of industries and offers tenants easy access to all points within the downtown.

The property has up to 100,000 square feet of space available for sublease consisting of the following:


- 75,000 square feet of contiguous space on floors 2. 3 and 4




WHY WORCESTER?
